Next, Patrick Gilbert, R&D Manager Life Sciences at Purolite explained how their investments are creating a healthy world with a better future. Purolite's focus is the development, manufacture, and support of resin technology for Ion Exchange, Adsorbents, Catalysts and Life Science applications.
