






## Mission


## The Health Technology Challenge www.htc.wales

- Open Innovation platform using an interactive website

Over £250K funding has been allocated to 16 projects

### Notable success stories so far

- Trip Advisor for Care Homes (Think about Me) over 95% sign-up of Care homes in Gwent, winner of Kate Grainger award 2015
- Product to reduce infection in joint replacements, patented and in discussion with industry
- Show me Where multilingual app and fan tool now being trialled with Wales Ambulance Service Trust
- About Me App to support autistic children launch 3 Nov 2016
- Product to treat infected wounds, patented and in discussion with potential manufacturers
- Prototype jigs for knee osteotomies developed with PDR for UHW surgeons – surgeries for 5 patients now scheduled
